- 1.1. The confirmation of prepayment of **min. 225PLN/60EUR** must be send with entries.
- 1.2. In case of withdrawing the entry 5 or more days before the event the prepayment will be return. For those who withdraw less than 5 days before event prepayment will not be return.
- 1.3. Those who withdraw less than 3 days before event or will not come to the event at all are obliged to pay all the payments included in the schedule with deadline of three days after the event.
- 1.4. In case of entering one rider on more than 4 horses (on condition full payment with the box fee) the fifth horse will be charged only half the payment.
- 1.5. In case of more than 100 horses being entered the organizer has a right to limit the admission and create the reserve list. The order of entering will be deciding.
- 1.6 . Late entry- Organizer has a right to not admit the entry of horses- riders, which are entered after the deadline. Organizer can, as far as possible, admit additional horses- riders entered after the deadline for an extra charge of 50 PLN/15 EUR.
- 1.7. After publishing the starting orders all changes in the entries are possible only if agreed with Organizer and after making an extra payment of 50 PLN/15EUR.

#### 1. Insurances

They are therefore strongly advised to take out a third-party insurance providing full coverage for participation in equestrian events at home and abroad and to keep the policy up to date.

#### 2. Veterinary matters

Horses competing must comply with the requirements for Equine Influenza vaccination in accordance with the Veterinary Regulations and as summarised below.

# THE FEI CODE OF CONDUCT

# FOR THE WELFARE OF THE HORSE

The Fédération Equestre Internationale (FEI) expects all those involved in international equestrian sport to adhere to the FEI's Code of Conduct and to acknowledge and accept that at all times the welfare of the horse must be paramount and must never be subordinated to competitive or commercial influences.

- 1. At all stages during the preparation and training of competition horses, welfare must take precedence over all other demands. This includes good horse management, training methods, farriery and tack, and transportation.
- 2. Horses and Athletes must be fit, competent and in good health before they are allowed to compete. This encompasses medication use, surgical procedures that threaten welfare or safety, pregnancy in mares and the misuse of aids.
- 3. Events must not prejudice horse welfare. This involves paying careful attention to the competition areas, ground surfaces, weather conditions, stabling, site safety and fitness of the horse for onward travel after the event.
- 4. Every effort must be made to ensure that horses receive proper attention after they have competed and that they are treated humanely when their competition careers are over. This covers proper veterinary care, competition injuries, euthanasia and retirement.

# 5. The FEI urges all involved with the sport to attain the highest levels of education in their areas of expertise.
